

# **How do I cite the DSM-5-TR e-version when there are no page numbers ?**

**To cite the electronic edition of the DSM-5-TR, in the Reference List, for the whole book, cite it as follows.** This is in line with APA guidelines from page 324 of "The Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, Seventh Edition."

## **Reference List (Whole Book):**

American Psychiatric Association. (2022). Diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders (5th ed., text rev.).

If you want to cite just a section, there are two ways you can do it:

## **Lead with Entry Title:**

Avoidant personality disorder. (2022). In Diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders (5th ed., text rev.).

## Lead with APA as Author:

American Psychiatric Association. (2022). Avoidant personality disorder. In Diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders (5th ed., text rev.).

For **in-text citation**, use the following formats:

- (American Psychiatric Association, 2022) **or** ("Avoidant personality disorder," 2022).
- If you will be citing the **APA multiple times in-text** and are using an author lead in your reference list, your first citation should be (American Psychiatric Association [APA], 2022) **and all subsequent citations as** (APA, 2022).
