How do I cite the DSM-5-TR e-version when there are no page numbers ?

To cite the electronic edition of the DSM-5-TR, in the Reference List, for the whole book, cite it as follows. This is in line with APA guidelines from page 324 of "The Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, Seventh Edition."

Reference List (Whole Book):

If you want to cite just a section, there are two ways you can do it:

Lead with Entry Title:

Avoidant personality disorder. (2022). In Diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders (5th ed., text rev.).

Lead with APA as Author:

For **in-text citation**, use the following formats:

- (American Psychiatric Association, 2022) or ("Avoidant personality disorder," 2022).
- If you will be citing the APA multiple times in-text and are using an author lead in your reference list, your first citation should be (American Psychiatric Association [APA], 2022) and all subsequent citations as (APA, 2022).
