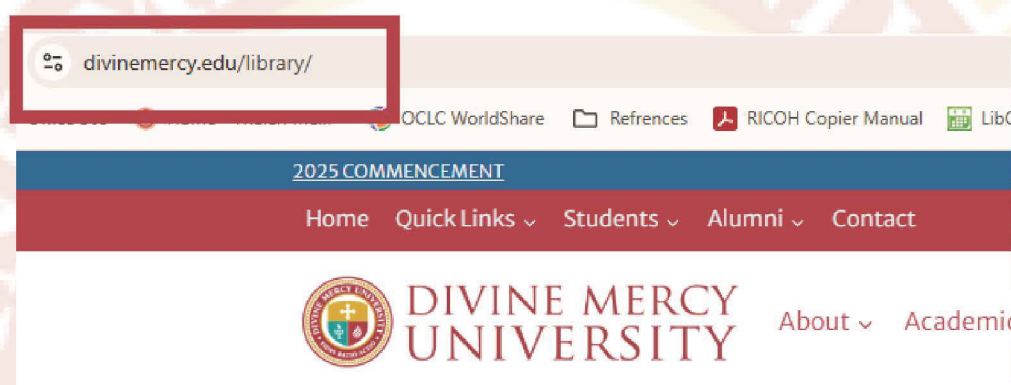




Using Mental Measurements Yearbook with Tests in Print MMY & TIP Tutorial

1. **Navigate to the DMU Library home page at** <https://divinemercy.edu/library/>. We recommend that you bookmark or favorite the page so that you can easily return in the future. For assistance on this, please contact the library.

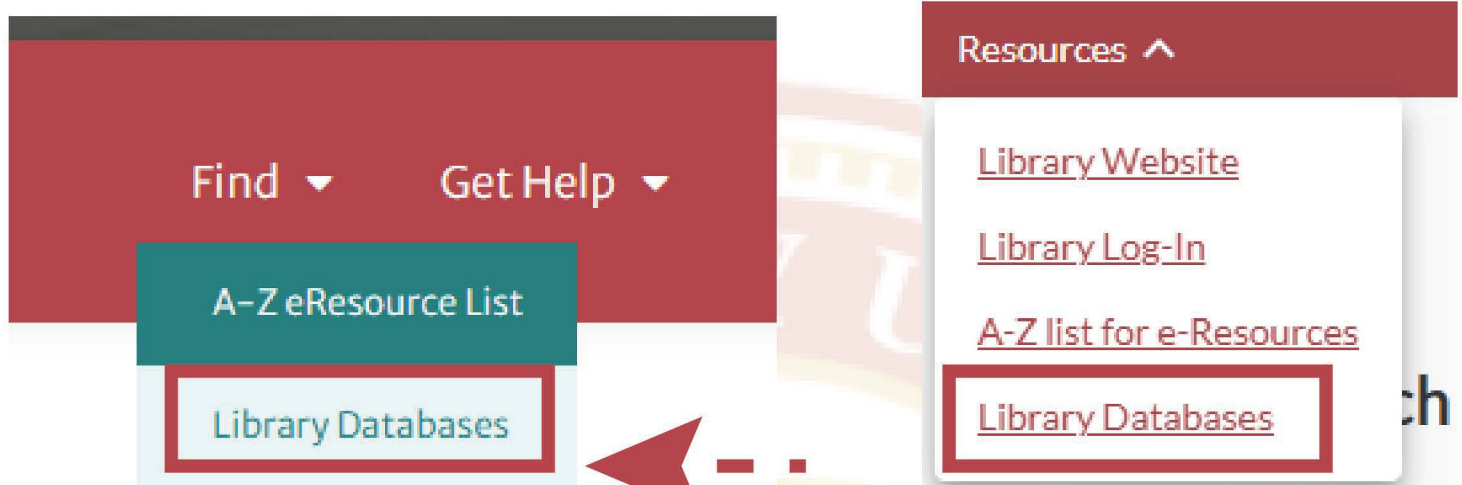


2. **Sign in using the “Library Log-In” link at the top navigation bar.** Doing so will allow you to utilize more of the library’s electronic resources that require authentication. Then, sign in using your unique barcode you got via email, and password. You will be forwarded to a search page.

5. The “Search” Function is on top

-“Basic Search” uses keywords and is the quickest way to find articles. It works like similar to a search engine.

When you search the Mental Measurements Yearbook (MMY) in EBSCOhost, you’re really searching reviews of psychological tests. The search works like other EBSCO databases, but with a few points to keep in mind:

Basic Search: You can type in the name of a test (e.g., WAIS-IV), a test acronym, or a topic (e.g., “anxiety scale”). The system will pull up reviews, descriptions, and details from the MMY.

Advanced Search: Lets you combine keywords using Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT), limit by fields (like test acronym or test title), or narrow by publication (MMY only, or include Tests in Print).

Results: Entries usually include a summary of the test, its intended purpose, target population, publisher, and at least one expert review that evaluates its reliability, validity, and practical use.

Filters: You can refine results by subject terms, publication year, or reviewer.

Use the test name or acronym as your starting point, and use Advanced Search if you want to explore by test category.

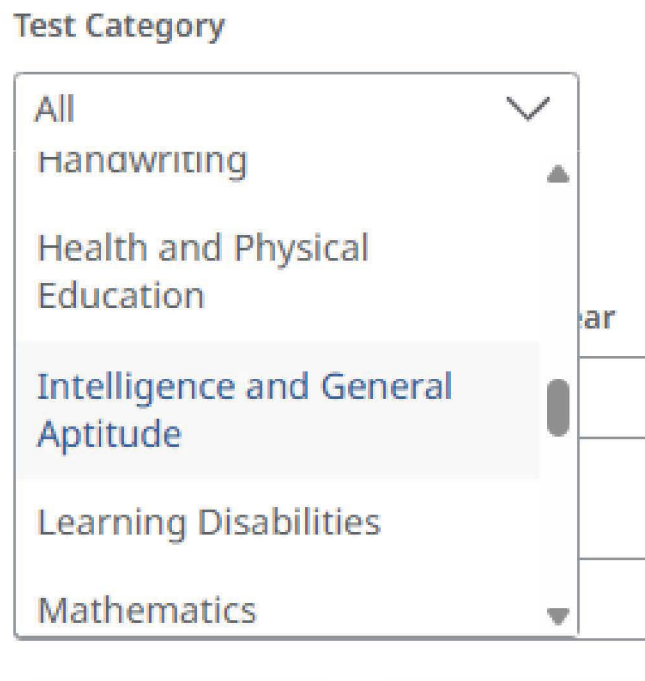

6. Searching by Category in MMY on EBSCO



In addition to typing in a test name or keyword, you can also search by Test Category. This feature helps if you don't already know the title of a specific test but want to explore tests within a certain field.

Locate the Category Menu: On the search screen, look for the "Test Category" dropdown box.

Choose a Category: Options include areas like Personality, Psychology, Reading, Record and Report Forms, Science, and more.

Run the Search: Once you select a category, EBSCO will return all tests that fall under that subject area.

Review Results: Each record typically includes the test description, intended population, publisher details, and professional reviews.

Refine Further: You can combine category searching with keywords (e.g., "anxiety" within Personality), or use Advanced Search filters to narrow by reviewer, year, or
